1.1 QualityRelease 5067.001 | Introduction

1.2 Pay Raise

1.2.1 Pay Raise | Status Change

Task #9897 | 5067.001

An HR user can change the status from "Approved" back to "Pending Approval." This is not possible with supervisor permissions if the "Department Permissions" field is enabled in the SwissSalary user settings.

1.2.2 Pay Raise | Columns locked

Task #10529 | 5067.001

To give managers a better overview when distributing pay raises, the "Last Name," "First Name," and "Employee ID" fields are displayed and pinned.

All columns up to and including the "Last Name" field are pinned. If the "Last Name" column is moved far to the right using the "Customize" feature, usability may be affected.

1.3 Personal

1.3.1 Security Filter | Insurance and Benefit Coverages

Task #12092 | 5067.001

In SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were made to the security filters that were causing errors for users with Allocation Group.

Benefit entitlements were not being inherited from the Allocation Group default settings and HR templates when creating new employees. This issue has been resolved.

1.4 Payroll

1.4.1 Security Filter | Tapboard

Task #11684 | 5067.001 [1.5067000.2002.0]

In SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were made to the security filters that caused errors for users with Allocation Group.

The TapBoard was no longer displayed and could no longer be used. This issue has been resolved.

1.4.2 Security Filter | Social security deductions

Task #11745 | 5067.001 [1.5067000.2002.0]

In SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were made to the security filters that were causing errors for users with a Allocation Group filter.

For payroll runs processed by a user with a Allocation Group filter, social security deductions were not calculated correctly. This issue has been resolved.

1.4.3 Security Filter | Single Parent Family

Task #11781 | 5067.001 [1.5067000.2004.0]

In SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were made to the security filters that were causing errors for users with a Allocation Group filter.

Users with a Allocation Group filter were unable to process payroll if employees subject to withholding tax were to be processed using rate H. This issue has been resolved.

1.5 Reports

1.5.1 Staff Turnover List | Reasons for Departure

Task #11889 | 5067.001

With version 5067.000, the ability to store translations for reasons for leaving was added. This caused an error message to appear in the turnover list if no translations had been stored. This issue has been resolved.

1.6 Interfaces

1.6.1 Open Interface | Error Log

Task #11748 | 5067.001 [5067.000.2002.0]

Update 5067.000 caused an error message to appear when using the open interface. This error message has been fixed in a hotfix.

1.6.2 SmartPort | SIMIC No.

Task #10940 | 5067.001

The Smartport import now also accepts six-digit numbers with a check digit (xxxxxx.x).

1.7 SwissSalary Budget

1.7.1 Budget | Forecast

Task #11320 | 5067.001

In the SwissSalary Budget, forecast items for new hires and vacancies are now calculated by payroll accounting only starting from the start date.

1.8 SwissSalary EasyRapport

1.8.1 Security Filter | EasyRapport Employee Deactivated

Task #11942 | 5067.001

In SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were made to the Allocation Group filter. As a result, employees were deactivated for EasyRapport when a user performed the transfer using the Allocation Group filter. This issue has been resolved.

1.9 SwissSalary Direct

1.9.1 Security Filter | Direct Synchronization

Task #11888 | 5067.001 [1.5067.001.2000.0]

With SwissSalary version 5067.000, changes were implemented to the Allocation Group filters. This affected synchronization with SwissSalary Direct.

If a Allocation Group filter is set for a user, that user will only see employees from the corresponding Allocation Group. However, if employees outside these payroll areas make changes to a person's information—such as their address—and these changes are ready to be synchronized, the system cannot find these employees because it lacks access. As a result, these employees are marked as deleted in the SwissSalary Direct portal.

When logging in, the user is then recognized as a new user in Direct and must re-register. The documents are also no longer visible.

With hotfix 5067.001, a clear separation of Allocation Group is possible, and users can no longer be deleted due to changes made by users in other Allocation Group.
